STAKES Holy Bull S. Grade 3 - Thoroughbred

FOR THREE YEAR OLDS. Free nomination by Saturday, January 12, 2013, \$4,000 to pass the entry box and \$2,000 additional to start, with \$400,000 Guaranteed. Plus and additional \$40,000 to the owner of the winner if the winning horse is a registered Florida Bred by a registered Florida Stallion. All fees shall be paid prior to the start of the race. The owner of the winner to receive \$240,000, \$80,000 to second, \$40,000 to third, \$20,000 to fourth, \$12,000 to fifth and \$8,000 to sixth. Supplemental nominations may be at time of entry a fee of \$20,000, which includes entry and starting fees. Weight: 122 lbs. Non-winners of a grade I or II stakes allowed, 2 lbs.; of a sweepstakes at a mile or over, 4 lbs.; of two races other than maiden or claiming at a mile or over, 6 lbs.; Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Horses finishing first, second or third in the Holy Bull will automatically be nominated to the Florida Derby. This race will be limited to 14 Starters, with AlsoEligibles. If more than fourteen(14) entries pass the entry box preference will be given to graded stakes winners, then highest career earnings. Trophy to the winning owner. Nominations Closed Saturday, January 12, 2013 with 51 Nominations.

Footnotes

ITSMYLUCKYDAY broke on top and settled in just off the top two leaders in the opening quarter, angled out and moved in equal terms with the leader at the quarter pole, vied along the outside of SHANGHAI BOBBY into the deep stretch, shook free at the eighth pole and drew clear in the final sixteenth. SHANGHAI BOBBY was away well and took the lead by a slight margin in opening stages, continued to set the pace along the inside in the backstretch, was challenged by rivals nearing the quarter pole, began to duel for the lead with ITSMYLUCKYDAY, they battled for the lead into the stretch, could not match strides with rival at after the eighth pole but finished a clear second. CLEARLY NOW raced just off the leader in opening stages, continued to press the pace in the backstretch, was urged to make a bid for the leaders heading into the far turn, continued within contention in the upper stretch and flattened out in the drive. JOSHUA'S COMPRISE was unhurried in opening stages and allowed to settle in the back of rivals, continued patiently heading for home, began to pick up the pace in the upper stretch and gained ground to the wire. BERN IDENTITY was bumped repeatedly at the start, recovered quickly and settled in along the inside, stalked the pace in the backstretch, shifted out slightly in the far turn and continued a even bid into the stretch. FRAC DADDY settled in along the rail in opening stages, continued to stalk the pace in the backstretch, asked for response nearing the far turn, raced three wide into the

lane and failed to kick in the drive. DEWEY SQUARE was unhurried in early stages and tracked the front runners, asked to pick up the pace nearing the far turn, slightly improved position and flattened out shortly after. SR. QUISQUEYANO broke in and bumped at the start, settled in near the back of the pack, stalked the pace two to three off the inside and failed to respond in the drive. TULIRA CASTLE raced four wide going into the first turn, settled in and stalked the early pace, began to weaken after a half mile and was distanced in the stretch. FREDERICKSBURG raced five wide going into the first turn, stalked the front runners in the opening quarter, lacked response after a half mile and was distanced in the stretch.
