FOR FOUR YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD. Free nomination by Saturday December 29, 2012, \$1,000 to pass the entry box and \$500 additional to start, with \$150,000 Guaranteed. All fees shall be paid prior to the start of the race. The owner of the winner to receive \$90,000, \$30,000 to second, \$15,000 to third, \$7,500 to fourth, \$4,500 to fifth and \$3,000 to sixth. Supplemental nominations may be made at time of entry for a fee of \$7,500, which includes entry and starting fees. Weight: 123 lbs. Non-winners of a gradel or II stakes at a mile or over on the turf since August 1, allowed 2 lbs.; of a sweepstakes at a mile or over on the turf since July 1, 4lbs., \$45,000 twice at a mile or over since August 1, 6 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. This race will be limited to 14 Starters, with Also Eligibles. If more than fourteen (14) entries pass the entry box preference will be given to graded stakes winners, then highest 2011-2013 earnings. Trophy to the winning owner. Nominations Closed Saturday, December 29, 2012 with 41 Nominations. (If deemed inadvisable to run this race over the turf course, it will be run on the main track at One Mile and One Sixteenth) (Rail at 12 feet).

Footnotes

MUCHO MAS MACHO was well reserved in opening stages and settled in near the back of rivals, continued patiently behind rivals heading into far turn, swung out three wide in turn, angled out slightly at top of lane, surged along outside in stretch and was up just in time to prevail. TIZ SARDONIC JOE away quickly and pulled slightly in opening stages, settled in along outside of rival and tracked the pace, began to inch up to lead nearing far turn, raced three deep at top of the lane, battled for lead into deep stretch, slightly took command and was caught at the wire. BIG BLUE KITTEN stalked front runners in opening stages, angled out slightly nearing turn, raced behind wall of horses in upper stretch, squeezed between rivals, gained position, urged between again, raced within contention of lead but lacked final kick. NIKKI'S SANDCASTLE allowed to settle in early stages, asked to pick up pace heading into far turn, fanned out five wide at top of stretch, gained ground under right handed urging and slightly flattened out in late drive. QUICK WIT vied for lead out of the gate, settled back slightly and tracked the pacesetter, made a bid for lead nearing turn, inched up to lead, vied between rivals in late drive and failed to kick on to make serious impact. EMPIRE BUILDER stalked the pacesetters in backstretch, began to pick up pace nearing far turn, angled out four wide at top of lane, and finished evenly five wide in stretch. VERTIFORMER lacked speed in early stages racing in back of rivals, continued in back of rivals heading

into stretch, slightly gained position but was too late to be a threat. SKY BLAZER stalked pace along rail in backstretch, wanted to pick up pace heading into turn, lacked racing room, settled back a bid, angled out, blocked behind horses upper stretch, steadied slightly, slipped thru tight quarters and flattened out in late strides. HOLLINGER tracked pace in early stages, slightly gained position heading into far turn and came up empty in drive. FIFTY PROOF set pace along outside in early stages, challenged by rivals heading into far turn, could not keep up the pace and faded at top of the lane.
