DISCREET DANCER pressed the pace off the rail, moved to take over on the turn, then drew off while being ridden out. SWAGGER JACK bumped with GOURMET DINNER at the start, chased the pace three wide into the stretch, then was no match for the winner while continuing on with good courage for the place. FORT LOUDON set the pace under pressure along the inside to midway of the turn, then tired. GOURMET DINNER bumped and steadied at the start, tracked the leaders off the rail to nearing the stretch and faltered. DECAF AGAIN showed early foot along the rail and faded. FORT LARNED stumbled badly at the start unseating his rider. THERE WAS A STEWARDS INQUIRY INTO THE INCIDENT AT THE START.
