DELAND had aim at the leading trio two wide into the turn, edged closer being roused past the five-sixteenths, tipped out to the three-path in upper stretch, caught ZIPPING past the furlong marker and drew away while drifting out. ZIPPING chased outside CONQUEST BIG E through a sharp half-mile, rallied between horses to take a short lead late on the turn, drew clear under an all-out drive in upper stretch, and yielded grudgingly in the last sixteenth of a mile. HY RIVERSIDE lagged at the back for nearly six furlongs, angled widest for the drive and rallied for a share while not a serious threat. MR. JORDAN pressed the pace three wide, was all in by late on the turn, and weakened through the lane. ROYAL HOLIDAY came off the inside passing the five-sixteenths marker, and failed to fire in the three-path. CONQUEST BIG E hustled up to get the lead inside, rolled through a fast half-mile, got collared by two rivals near the five-sixteenths and wilted on the rail. BIG DADDY (CHI) saved ground to the stretch and was always outrun.
