Weight: 123 lbs. The maximum number of starters for the Toyota Blue Grass will be limited to fourteen. In the event that more than fourteen pass the entry box, the fourteen starters will be determined at that time with preference given to graded stakes winners (in order I-II-III), then highest earnings. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Keeneland will present a trophy cup to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, February 16, 2019 with 143 nominations.

**Footnotes**

VEKOMA tracked the pace early, angled off the rail into the lane while taking over command then drew away late in the stretch under a steady drive. WIN WIN WIN was bumped at the start and raced back early on, steadied near the five sixteenth pole, fanned into the five path in the far turn, rallied down the lane, was rolling late and was up for place in the final stages. SIGNALMAN stalked the pace early on, shifted into the four path in the far turn, made a bid in the stretch, battled down the lane, inched clear for place but lost it at the wire. SOMELIKEITHOTBROWN set the pace early, shifted into the three path in the far turn and faltered late in the stretch run. CHESS CHIEF chased the pace early, shifted into the four path in the far turn and leveled off late in the stretch drive. SO ALIVE was in tight a bit after leaving the gate and raced back early on, shifted into the four path in the far turn and moved up in the stretch run. SIR WINSTON was bumped at the start and raced back early on, was bothered near the five sixteenth pole, swung into the six path in the far turn and improved position down the lane. ADMIRE came out at the start, chased the pace early, was asked along the far turn but had no response and was empty down the lane. MOONSTER was never a threat. LUCKY LEE bobbed at the start, steadied in the first turn, angled off the rail into the lane and was no factor thereafter. MARKET KING stalked the pace early, shifted into the four path in the far turn and was tired in the stretch drive. AQUADINI was never a factor. DREAM MAKER fought restraint along the first turn and into the backstretch then was through after a half. PARSIMONY chased the pace early, fanned into the five path in the far turn and was tired down the lane.
