Footnotes

LET chased four wide early, was on top of the pace on the backside while four wide, was roused three wide on the final turn, took command rather easily at the quarter pole, was three wide into the stretch and drew clear late. CASANOVA MARKET tracked nicely three wide early, was three wide for the backside run, was under a furious drive between foes on the final turn two wide, loomed boldly four wide into the stretch and got up for second. TOOKIN DOWN close up early two wide, engaged the pacesetter two wide for the backstretch journey, took the lead into the far turn two wide, was hooked on the turn, lost the lead in upper stretch and weakened slightly to third. TOO TOO DIVINE hopped at start, was very rank early as the rider attempted to rate him early along the rail, was on top of horses heels and was shuffled back for the backside run along the rail, wa roused heavily on the final turn while four wide and ran even late. SALT IT hard used to set the pace early, took pace pressure down the backside, retreated on the final turn and stopped badly.
