ENERGIZED slow early, trailed to the lane and outside into the stretch, was brushed passing the eighth pole then finished well while drawing out late. DONT TELL THE KIDS moved to the front on the turn, drew clear then was no match late while best of the rest. POLISH MISSILE saved ground on the turn, was taken outside for the drive, drifted slightly and brushed with the winner a furlong out then lacked the needed response. TROUNCE always a factor from the outside, lodged a bid nearing the top of the lane and loomed a solid threat then weakened in the drive. DANCE MASTER showed the early way, remained a factor to the drive and gave way. MICHAEL'S PRIDE between foes early, dropped back on the turn then tired through the stretch.
