ERLTON rated back off of the speed early, settled three wide, steadily advanced into the stretch, drew clear near the eighth pole then held sway under strong handling. JEANIES ROB rushed up along the inside to press the pace, dropped back a bit near the quarter pole then battled back gamely along the rail to be second best. JOVIAL BRUSH, four wide most of the trip, circled the turn and found his best stride too late. TORO ROJO saved ground and lacked a solid response. TEXAS GLITTER broke sharply, set a brisk pace in the two path, shook clear after a half mile then gave way leaving the furlong marker. SAGTHUN (VEN), inside on the turn, angled out some in the drive and lacked a rally. PERFECT SCORE, three wide early, dropped back on the turn.
