PLEASANT PRINCE within striking distance outside rivals from start, moved willingly leaving far turn, came five wide into stretch, responded to mild urging to take over mid stretch, unchallenged, ridden out to wire. TIMELY PURSUIT moved quickly to the front after break, set pace into stretch, no match for winner in drive but held well and was a clear second. STACHYS was allowed to settle in stride for half, moved up while outside rivals leaving far turn, came five wide into stretch, finished with a belated mid track rally. NO HESITATION stalked leader into stretch, gave way. MONSIGNOR chased pace into stretch, gave way. DISTORTED ECONOMY forwardly positioned for three quarters, no response when asked. HOLIDAY BUZZ was never a factor. PARIS VEGAS was never a threat. PROFESSOR POLLARD was outrun.
