Footnotes

TILDE three deep into the first turn, stalked outside a rival, bid three wide into the stretch then outside the runner-up, gained a slim lead in deep stretch and gamely prevailed under urging and strong handling. DOINGHARDTIMEAGAIN had speed inside then took back leaving the first turn and came out, bid again alongside a rival to duel for the lead, inched away midway on the second turn, fought back inside the winner through a stiff drive and continued gamely to the end. COTTON'S POINT settled inside, came out into the stretch and split horses at the wire for the show, then was unsaddled at the end of the stretch but walked off. AKISS FORAROSE angled in and stalked inside, came out into the stretch, drifted inward in the drive and was edged late for third. AWE GOLLY MOLLY three deep into the first turn, chased outside, went three wide on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and was edged for a minor award outside foes on the line. QIAONA was a bit awkwardly into stride, chased between foes then outside a rival, continued a bit off the rail on the second turn and did not rally. WARREN'S SUGARBUZZ settled inside then a bit off the rail leaving the backstretch and on the second turn and did not rally. SACRED DELIGHT pulled her way along and steadied early on the backstretch, chased a bit off the rail, went three deep on the second turn and into the stretch and weakened. BERT'S ALTARCATION had speed outside the runner-up then inched away leaving the first turn and angled in, dueled inside, dropped back leaving the second turn and in the stretch and weakened. GRADUATOR four wide into the first turn, chased three deep, dropped back off the

rail on the second turn and had little left for the stretch.
