FOR TWO YEAR OLDS. By subscription of \$350 each which should accompany the nomination; \$1,750 to pass the entry box and an additional \$1,750 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental payment of \$3,500 along with the entry and starting fees may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among the remaining finishers. 122 lbs. Non-winners of \$60,000 allowed 2lbs; a race other than maiden allowed 4 lbs.; maidens allowed 6 lbs. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner, trainer and jockey. Closed Saturday August 22, 2015 with 19 Original Nominations and 1 Supplement.

RALIS established a good position in the early going, was forwardly placed on the outside, ranged up in the three path on the turn, made a bid while shaken up at the quarter-pole, took over at the three-sixteenths, disposed of MAGNA LIGHT at the furlong marker then came under a right-handed whip and drew off under steady urging. MAGNA LIGHT was away alertly, went to the front, set the pace on an uncontested lead, controlled the action while near the rail on the turn, was asked at the top of the stretch, came under a right-handed whip just after being headed at the three-sixteenths and proved no match while clear for the place. UNCLE VINNY dropped back while ridden along on the outside, went four wide early on the turn, dropped to the two path near the five-sixteenths and earned the show while no match for the top two. SALLISAW broke a half-step slow then bumped with SET THE TRAPPE, moved up on the inside to race just off the pace, was coaxed along while inside on the turn, spun off the rail into the stretch, came under a left-handed whip, drifted out some near the furlong marker then was switched to a right-handed whip and weakened. TOM'S READY settled off the pace, came under coaxing leaving the backstretch, was placed under stronger encouragement while two then three wide on the turn, came under the whip outside the quarter-pole, shifted four wide into the stretch and failed to rally. SET THE TRAPPE broke a half-step slow then bumped with SALLISAW, moved up loosely between horses, raced just off the pace while inside of the winner, raced in the two path on the turn, dropped back under pressure into upper stretch and came up empty. BULLET GONE ASTRAY settled on the outside, came under urging outside the half-mile pole, went five then four wide on the turn and failed to respond.
