Footnotes

ENCHANTED OUTLAW was rated on the front end just outside RUNNIN RED, moved ahead when asked leaving the second turn then gradually lengthened under a mild drive. LESTERS SECRET settled between horses, weaved through traffic commencing his bid on the second turn, was blocked with a quarter mile left, squeezed through four wide at the head of the lane and took over second near the sixteenth marker. SOME GHOST in midpack early between horses, closed the gap three wide on the turn, lost ground fanning to path six for the drive then steadily improved position and caught FULL OF ENERGY for third late. FULLOFENERGY was prominent from inside, angled out three wide for a clear path leaving the second turn and lacked the needed stretch bid. OCEAN JOE advanced from inside on the backstretch, was steadied when his path was taken on the second turn, came off the rail some then had to weave through traffic through the lane to progress. RUNNIN RED broke alertly, soon gained the inside, was challenged on the backstretch, could not stay with ENCHANTED OUTLAW into the stretch and gradually wore down. DOUBLE SMART forwardly placed from the beginning, also swung out for a clear path leaving the second turn, lost his path near the eighth pole, was altered in and had no late bid. SILVER MATTHAIS without early foot between horses, angled out on the second turn, lost ground fanning to path eight into the lane then bumped repeatedly with SPELLING BEE JONES. SPELLING BEE JONES soon trailed from outside, swung widest leaving the second turn and bumped repeatedly with SILVER MATTHAIS through the stretch. CATTLEMAN PROSPECT inattentive when the gate opened, left awkwardly, advanced from outside but gave way five wide on the second turn. Z Z DOME was an early contender toward the outside, four wide on the second bend then flattened out between rivals in the stretch.
