Footnotes

MR. ZACH MAN showed first, was rated between horses, two wide on the second turn, altered out to path four at the top of the stretch, responded to a steady drive and caught QUE PASO at the wire. QUE PASO progressed five wide on the backstretch, went for the lead three wide on the second bend, moved clear in the lane, angled in after entering the last eighth, tried hard but had to settle for second best. CONTINUUM was soon well back, stayed off the inside, three to five wide on the second turn, closed well and got up for third near the wire. CLASSY ARRANGEMENT broke outward, moved clear two wide on the backstretch, was challenged on the second turn, no match for QUE PASO in the lane and slowly wore down. SHARM displayed early speed inside but gradually wore down into the second turn. SHINE MISS COMET bumped with FIDDLERS CAT at the start, faded three wide on the backstretch and stayed well off the inside the rest of the way. FIDDLERS CAT bumped at the start, advanced outside to loom a serious threat four wide on the second turn but faltered the last quarter mile.
