KEEPONDEALING within striking distance four wide, bumped with CINDY'S HOBBY in upper stretch then drew clear late. SOUL ONARAZORSEGE forced the pace three wide, gained a short lead in upper stretch and held on gamely in the drive. PLATINUM STREAK reserved early, advanced off the inside on the turn, was angled out for the drive but lodged only a mild late bid. SPANISH GLITTER vied for the lead between rivals, held on well to deep stretch and weakened. CINDY'S HOBBY forced the pace from the rail, steadied once in the turn when in tight, drifted out a bit and bumped the winner in upper stretch then held on gamely. SHOW ME THE WIRE outrun early, found her best stride too late. JOKE contested the early pace between rivals, moved down to the rail with three furlongs to go then tired in the final furlong. LOGAN'S GIRL never far back while four wide, tired.
