MR. TRIESTE prompted the early pace three wide, sustained a bid into the stretch to gain the advantage and pulled away in the final furlong. SILVER AXE was unhurried early three wide, angled out five wide at the quarter pole and finished willingly to gain the place. DON'T STRIKE OUT pressed the early pace from the inside, dueled with INAMORATO to the top of the stretch, fought gamely then yielded in the final going. R. ASSOCIATE chased the early leaders racing off the rail and failed to sustain a bid. INAMORATO set a pressured early pace from between rivals, then dueled with DON'T STRIKE OUT to the top of the stretch and came up empty in the drive.
