Footnotes

SERENGETI EMPRESS was away in good order, crossed over to set the pace along the inside into the first turn, shook clear before going a half, dug in to meet the bid of LIORA approaching the furlong marker, repelled that one and held defiantly. LIORA settled under a snug hold into the first turn, leveled into stride between rivals, took closer order through the second turn, took dead aim on the leader once straightened for the drive, but was unable to best the determined winner. LADY APPLE was close up toward the inside, shifted out entering the stretch, was unable to go on with the top two, then was all out to hold the show. CHAMPAGNE ANYONE was caught in tight and shuffled back into the first turn, was unhurried thereafter to the far turn, angled out and commenced a rally into the stretch and was making up ground. BELLAFINA settled between horses, moved into striking distance through the second turn, tipped out into the lane, but toiled in vain through the drive. JAYWALK came in at the start putting POSITIVE SPIRIT on heels, settled into stride attending the pace four wide, came five wide into the stretch but failed to make headway. STREET BAND was put in tight early and shuffled back, settled five wide but failed to threaten thereafter. CHOCOLATE KISSES was allowed to settle along the inside and finished with a mild rally between horses. MOTION EMOTION steadied slightly into the first turn, moved up to engage the leader, settled off of the pace on the backstretch, was within reach to the lane and tired. JELTRIN was allowed to settle four wide, was fanned out further leaving the second turn and was never a factor. OUT FOR A SPIN saved ground to little avail. FLOR DE LA MAR was unhurried, came six wide and showed little. RESTLESS RIDER lagged at the tail of the field along the inside and never had a response. POSITIVE SPIRIT was squeezed at the start, clipped heels, fell but walked off. Following a Stewards inquiry into the start, JAYWALK was disqualified from sixth and placed thirteenth for coming in and taking the path of POSITIVE SPIRIT, forcing that one over heels.
