Footnotes

ENTICED came out at the start, was bumped and bothered into the first turn, fanned into the eight path in the far turn, made a bid three wide down the lane, was under a long drive in the final stages and prevailed at the wire. TIZ MISCHIEF was unhurried early on, shifted into the three path in the far turn, rallied into the lane, made a bid in the stretch from between horses, was under a long drive late and just missed at the wire. PROMISES FULFILLED broke awkwardly at the start, set the pace, was getting out while entering the backstretch, settled and stayed on the lead down the backstretch, was getting out into the far turn, shifted into the four path entering the lane, stayed on down the lane but yielded late in the drive. HIGH NORTH steadied and was bothered by a loose foe during the first turn, was off the rail entering the lane, rallied up the rail in the stretch with a late gain in the final stages. LONE SAILOR was unhurried early on, fanned into the five path in the far turn with a belated gain in the stretch run. RERIDE stalked the pace early on, made a bid from between horses into the lane but weakened late in the stretch drive. QUIP chased the pace early, steadied near the five sixteenth pole, shifted into the four path entering the lane and faded late in the stretch. GIVEMEAMINIT was bumped around going into the first turn, fanned into the five path in the far turn and

was empty down the lane. JOHN TIPPMANN checked avoiding fallen rider into the first turn. BRAVAZO was never a threat. ARRIVAL came in early on, steadied and was bothered into the first turn, fanned into the seven path in the far turn while making a bold bid but was tired down the lane. PEPPERED was carried out in the first turn by loose foe. GOTTA GO was bumped and bothered into the first turn, was in tight and steadied near the five sixteenth pole. DIAMOND KING was in tight, clipped heels and lost the rider into the first turn.
