DIXIE DREAMER rated off the pace, angled outside BEREBA in the stretch, then was floated out by that rival while rallying to be just up at the wire. RGIROLDOSN'TBLUFF stumbled at the start, made the pace while well in hand into the stretch, responded when set down approaching the eighth pole and just failed to last. BEREBA chased the pace, made a run to loom a threat in early stretch but couldn't gain late while drifting out. SARATOGA TANGO unhurried after being steadied along the inside on the backstretch, passed tired rivals. TENACIOUS GATOR chased the pace along the inside around the turn and tired. APPEALING RUNNER was outrun. SUAVE ROYALTY well placed after being caught in tight at the start, faltered leaving the turn.
