GIANT RYAN chased the pace along the inside, angled outside IRREFUTABLE in early stretch, then rallied under pressure to be up in the final strides. IRREFUTABLE showed speed off the rail, edged clear in midstretch, then just failed to last. NOBLE'S PROMISE stalked the pace off the rail, angled out in the stretch and was gaining on the top ones at the finish. ROYAL TRICON unhurried early, closed with a belated rally along the inside. HOW'S YOUR HALO tracked the leaders along the inside to midway of the turn, then tired. THIS ONES FOR PHIL prompted the pace three wide around the turn, then faltered.
