SILVER SEASON reserved along the rail, came around the tiring HIGH SECURITY entering the stretch, moved through inside to gain command at the eighth pole and edged away under steady urging. SON OF A PISTOL chased the pace three wide, drew even for command in the stretch but couldn't stay with the winner late. MY JEFF'S MOMBO chased the pace, gained a slim lead on the turn, then gave way in the drive. THRILLIN DISCOVERY made a run four wide on the turn to loom a threat leaving the turn, then weakened. STORMY DO, off slowly, raced five wide on the turn and faded. HIGH SECURITY (VEN) showed good speed along the inside and faltered. COWBOY COP was through early.
