**Footnotes**

BALLAST (IRE) chased the pace, rallied to catch SIPHON CITY entering the stretch, then edged away through the final eighth. BOB'S PROUD MOMENT tracked the pace along the hedge, angled out for the stretch run and finished willingly to be up for the place. DRUM MAJOR reserved early, advanced between horses around the far turn, then rallied to be up for the show. INTERPATATION unhurried early, rallied along the hedge to loom a threat in midstretch but didn't do enough late. CLASSIC CAMPAIGN allowed to settle after stumbling at the start, closed with a belated rally. CAN'T BEAT IT outrun early, advanced four wide around the far turn to reach contention, then flattened out. SIPHON CITY set the pace along the hedge, responded when headed by BALLAST entering the stretch, then gave way in the final eighth. KNIGHT IN FLIGHT chased the pace three wide to nearing the stretch, then tired. HOST rated off the pace after stumbling at the start, raced four wide on the far turn and faltered.
