FOR THREE YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD, ACCREDITED LOUISIANA BRED. Early bird nominations closed September 15, 2011 at \$150. Final closing on November 1, 2011 at \$500. \$700 to pass the entry box and \$700 additional to start. \$150,000 Guaranteed of which \$90,000 to the winner, \$30,000 to second, \$16,500 to third, \$9,000 to fourth, \$4,500 to fifth. Weight: Three Year Olds - 121 lbs. Older - 124 lbs. Non-winners of \$60,000 at a mile or over in 2011 allowed 2 lbs. \$36,000 twice at a mile or over in 2011 allowed 4 lbs. Non-winners of three races at a mile or over other than maiden, claiming or starter in 2011 allowed 6 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Preference to horses that have accumulated the highest total earnings in 2011. This Stake will be limited to 12 starters should race not be split. Different owners have equal draw according to money earned. Second choice high earners of a same owner entry receive no consideration over a single entry. Failure to draw into the race will cancel all fees. The owner of the winner to receive a trophy. Closed Tuesday, November 1, 2011, with 14 nominations. Footnotes

STAR GUITAR stalked BREAK UP while on the outside, was asked inside the quarter-pole, gained a short lead passing the furlong marker, edged clear into the final sixteenth and held under steady handling. POPULIST POLITICS raced off the rail on the first turn, settled off the pace, bided his time on the far turn, waited behind horses into the stretch, shifted out and was roused near the three-sixteenths pole and finished well for the place. BREAK UP was well rated while setting the pace on the inside, came under urging inside the quarter-pole, lost the lead entering the final furlong and was outfinished while well clear for the show. HEAVENVILLE raced three wide on the first turn, was rated on the outside, came under urging while three wide on the far turn, held a good striking position into the stretch but came up empty. EIGHTH AT CITYPARK lagged at the rear of the field while saving ground, was roused on the far turn and failed to respond.
