FILLIES AND MARES, FOUR YEARS OLD AND UPWARD. Free nomination by Sunday, February 2. \$1,500 to enter. \$150,000 Guaranteed. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weight: 124 lbs. Non-winners of a graded stakes at a mile or over since August 1 allowed 2 lbs.; a stakes since May 1, 4 lbs.; three races other than maiden, claiming, or starter, 6 lbs. Starters to be named by usual time of closing. Supplemental nominations may be made at time of entry. All fees shall be paid prior to the start of the race. Preference will be given to graded stakes winners since February 15, 2018, graded stakes placed since February, 15, 2018 then by highest career earnings.

COOKIE DOUGH tugged intently outside TWEETING under a snug hold early, ran past that one when given her cue midway on the far turn well out in the track, shifted wider still with GOLDEN AWARD looming to her outside and QUEEN NEKIA to her inside at the top of the stretch, and repelled those threats under steady pressure. GOLDEN AWARD was four wide up the backstretch eyeing the pacesetters in the clear, moved after COOKIE DOUGH from the outside past the three-eighths, got floated out a bit by the leader turning for home, neglected to change leads until very late and was just up for second outside. QUEEN NEKIA bounced off the left side of the gate lightly at the start, steadied briefly inside COACH ROCKS heading to the first turn, crept closer to the leaders after six furlongs, rallied in the two-path into the stretch and finished with good courage inside the top two. TWEETING set the pace inside, yielded to challengers after six furlongs, stayed on the rail and ran on late. COACH ROCKS was taken well out in the track leaving the first turn, and could not keep pace after six furlongs while remaining outside. RESTLESS RIDER trailed to the stretch and was allowed to fade away steadily. AN OBJECTION AGAINST THE WINNER BY THE RIDER OF GOLDEN AWARD ALLEGING INTERFERENCE AT THE TOP OF THE STRETCH WAS NOT ALLOWED.
