FOR THREE-YEAR-OLDS AND UPWARD. No nomination fee. \$250 to enter and \$250 additional to start. Supplementary nominations may be made at the time of entry Wednesday, December 13, 2006 by payment of \$2,500 each (includes all fees). \$50,000 Guaranteed. Monies to be divided 62% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weights: Three-Year-Olds; 123 lbs.; Older; 124 lbs. Non-winners of a Sweepstakes at a mile or over in 2006 allowed, 2 lbs.; \$25,000 twice at a mile or over in 2006, 4 lbs.; \$21,000 at a mile or over since October 5, 6 lbs. Starters and riders must be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. This race will be limited to twelve starters. Preference to start will be given in the following order: Graded/Group Stakes Winners (in order I-II-III). Stakes winners, then highest total earnings in 2006. In addition no same owner entry may start to the exclusion of a single entry. Failure to draw into the race cancels all fees. Closed Wednesday, December 6, 2006 with 35 Nominations.

Footnotes

SIDCUP close up early in traffic, was taken back after a quarter, made a bold five wide move after six furlongs, took over entering the stretch, drifted in in upper stretch, drew clear then lasted late. SPECIAL EVENT reserved along the inside, angled out on the backstretch, made a good five wide move on the second turn, angled outside the winner when that one drifted in in upper stretch then was coming again late. GIN AND SIN close up along the inside, lost position on the second turn then closed well late when clear. WAYZATA BAY outrun early off the rail, advanced three wide on the second turn and finished willingly. AWAY TO BOSTON pulled a bit early when within striking distance, challenged with three furlongs to go, could not keep pace with the top pair after six furlongs but was coming again with a mild late bid. VICTORY FLYER forwardly placed three wide, challenged before a half, gained a short lead, battled to the final quarter and weakened. MESAWMI within striking distance early five wide, stayed close up throughout but lacked a solid closing bid. AIR ACADEMY three wide early when reserved, raced four wide out of the second turn and could not threaten. SUMMER BOOK set the pace along the inside, held on well to the stretch and tired. CHIEF EXPORT stumbled at the start, quickly moved to a forward position, held on well to the stretch and tired.
