

DAISIES AND NITES well handled while setting the pace racing off the rail, drew off when set down for the drive. HOLY CAPOTE unhurried after breaking slowly, rallied four wide around the far turn and was up for the place while no threat to the winner. EXTENDED APPLAUSE stalked the pace along the inside, then weakened in the drive. DANCER'S ATTITUDE reserved while saving ground, had a mild response in the drive. CASH'S PRIDE lacked a late response. SCATTER BUY stalked the pace three wide around the far turn and tired. CLASS ON CLASS in good position racing four wide, faltered. FLIPFORTHGOLD showed little.
