SPRINGINTHECOUNTRY saved ground into the stretch, split rivals while rallying in early stretch, caught GRAND VERANDA just inside the eighth pole and drew clear under urging. SEJM'S LUNAR STAR unhurried early, angled out at the top of the stretch and rallied to be up for the place. GRAND VERANDA hit the gate at the start, slipped through along the hedge leaving the backstretch to get a slim lead, dueled with MISS GLITTERMAN into the stretch, edged away, then weakened in the final eighth. BEAUTY SWEEP reserved off the pace, made a run to reach near even terms for command three wide on the far turn and tired. CHRISTIE LIGHT chased the pace and faltered. MISS GLITTERMAN sprinted to a clear lead racing off the rail, dueled with GRAND VERANDA around the far turn and into the stretch, then was tiring when steadied nearing the eighth pole. FAR OUT SANDIE failed to menace. MOON'S DUSTY STAR was through after a half mile.
