NADAL allowed the pace to go early, settled in the three path while applying pressure to the leader, collared that rival turning for home, shook clear, geared down, ridden out. KING GUILLERMO raced in the second flight just off the inside, angled out slightly and loomed a threat three wide late in the final turn, proved no match in the drive, remained clear for the place. FINNICK THE FIERCE settled in the two path early, moved out slightly to be three wide turning for home, had little for the top pair the final furlong, finished best of the rest while not a threat to the top two. FARMINGTON ROAD fell back after the start, moved out, lodged a middle move four wide, failed to sustain that advance in the drive to finish up evenly. WELLS BAYOU broke sharp, got clear toward the inside, two path through the first turn, continued to set the pace, offered little resistance to the winner when confronted second turn, folded when headed by that rival by late in the final turn. STORM THE COURT within striking distance off the inside early, continued three out to four wide in the second turn, faded in the drive. SILVER PROSPECTOR three wide off the pace, dropped inside to save ground through the second bend, failed to fire through the stretch. CODE RUNNER broke in mid pack, raced back, was finished before a half. TAISHAN settled toward the inside, early, also was through early to be a non

factor.
