INNER DIRT FOR FOUR YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$100 each which should accompany the nominations; \$500 to pass the entry box and an additional \$500 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental nomination payment of \$1,000 along with the entry and starting fees may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The purse to be divided 60% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally amongst the remaining finishers. Weight, 123 lbs. Non-winners of a graded sweepstake in 2014-15 allowed 2 lbs.; of \$60,000 since July 1, 2014 other than state bred stake allowed 4 lbs.; of three races since then, 6 lbs.; of two such races since then, 8 lbs. (maiden, claiming, starter or restricted allowance races not considered.) A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, January 31, 2015 with 21 Original Nominations and 2 Supplements.

Footnotes

NORTH SLOPE brushed the off side stall at the start, settled three to four wide just off the pace, took closer order under light coaxing through the latter portion of the turn, angled four wide into upper stretch set down for the drive, took over straightened away, edged away under a drive to prevail. VILLAGE WARRIOR established the front shortly after the start, showed the way in hand four then three wide through the first turn, settled off inside four or five paths off the rail patiently handled through comfortable early fractions, had the pressure intensity in behind and came under urging three furlongs out slipping briefly away nearing the quarter pole, angled five wide for home let out, got headed straightened away, dug in under a drive and kept on safe for the place honors while unable to match the winner late on. TURCO BRAVO (CHI) three wide through the first turn, settled in range of the front four to five paths off the inside, came under a ride with five-sixteenths remaining, angled six wide into upper stretch, stayed on through the lane while offering no extra and was along for the show honors. MICROMANAGE three wide through the first turn, settled four to five wide towards the rear, came under encouragement midway on the far turn, angled six wide into upper stretch, offered no response while improving by tired foes for the last major share. STORMIN MONARCHO tracked the pace in closest aim two to three wide, got spirited up with five-sixteenths to run, cornered three wide into upper stretch, weakened in the drive. KID CRUZ three wide towards the rear, shifted in a path seven-sixteenths from home, came under a ride three furlongs out, spun just off the inside at the quarter pole, made no impact. MR PALMER coaxed along just off the inside in pursuit from mid pack, got placed to further encouragement at the seven-sixteenths, faded to the rear through the far turn, spun three wide for home and faltered.
