LOVELY SYN established the front to cut a solid pace just off the inside in hand, got put to encouragement at the quarter pole, went clear under a vigorous hand drive getting one off sided tap a furlong out then was geared down in the final strides. BIT BUSTIN tracked the pace along the inside urged from the five-sixteenths, cut the corner into the lane offering up a mild kick which proved no match for the top one while along for the place honors. SHARON SPAGETTI settled three wide towards the rear, came under a ride at the five-sixteenths, angled four wide into upper stretch, offered up a mild kick in the lane to procure the show while never threatening the winner. KEEP BUSTIN chased three wide under prolonged urging from the seven-sixteenths, offered no serious response then weakened in the stretch. JERUSALEM STONE outrun in the early going, saved ground through the turn urged from three furlongs out and made no impact. KILNOCKAGAIN chased the solid fractions from just off the inside under a prolonged drive from the seven-sixteenths, remained a forward factor to the quarter pole before giving way in the stretch.
