MARCH made light contact with COMPETITIVE EDGE as the field was sent off and running, was quickly guided over to the rail, rode it for over a half, slipped into the two path approaching the five-sixteenths marker, completed the rest of the way to the top of the lane and then got set down, launched a rally in earnest with clear sailing up ahead, got engaged in a duel with the second place finisher, went at it eye to eye with that opponent in the final sixteenth, forged to the slimmest of leads in the final stages and dug in gamely to stay in front. CINCO CHARLIE broke alertly and remained a forward factor, was coaxed in the two path keeping READY FOR RYE company, continued to race linked up to that foe on the turn, followed that one outward as they neared the top of the lane, swung four wide into the stretch, fought his way to a narrow advantage, got pounced upon by the top one, raced directly alongside that rival the rest of the way to the wire, got denied. READY FOR RYE was rated along the inside vying for command, drifted into the three path turning for home, yielded soon afterwards, weakened into the show slot. CLASSY CLASS well held racing down the backstretch, chased the pace from the four path on the turn, commenced the stretch one wider, lacked the needed response. TWO WEEKS OFF stalked the pace from the two path for most of the way to the five-sixteenths pole, flip-flopped with the winner at that juncture by getting placed onto the rail, was put to solid encouragement cutting the corner into the stretch, failed to slip past foes and gave way. COMPETITIVE EDGE brushed at the start, was lightly hand urged to come within range of the front runners, departed the backstretch from the three path, arrived at the quarter pole appearing to have little left and retreated.
