QUEZON broke out at the start bumping WONDERMENT lightly, chased four then three wide through the turn, came under light coaxing nearing the quarter pole, went six to seven wide at that station, rallied to take over command just inside the three-sixteenths and drew clear under a drive slipping a bit in the slop to the finish. WONDERMENT bumped at the start lightly by the aforementioned foe breaking in step and in turn leaned briefly on E WARFARE, chased three to four wide down the backstretch until tucked to the inside seven-sixteenths from home, came under coaxing five-sixteenths out, angled six to seven wide for home following the eventual winner into upper stretch, kept on for the place honors. COURT DANCER cut the pace in hand four then three wide through the turn spurting away midway on the bend, came under coaxing five-sixteenths from home, floated five to six wide into upper stretch coming under threat, got headed just inside the three-sixteenths and weakened through to the finish. FROSTY MARGARITA broke in at the start bumping E WARFARE lightly and leaning on that rival for a stride, chased five to six wide until tucked four wide into the turn, came under encouragement at the five-sixteenths, went seven wide into upper stretch, tired and was not persevered with through the final furlong. E WARFARE bumped lightly between foes at the start and leaned on, chased four to five wide, lost position into the turn struggling and striding a bit awkwardly, got placed to a protective hold, was steadily pulled up approaching the midway point on the turn and subsequently vanned off, then was reported to have bled.
