LINDSAY JEAN was content to trail the field to the second turn, advanced two deep at the three eighths, was steered out and circled four wide to the stretch, rallied when set down and dug in late to prevail. PHEIFFER saved ground while settling off the pace, bid two then three wide on the second turn, rallied when set down for the drive but was outfinished late but finished on even terms with MARTY'S ZEE. The latter set the pace to the second turn, responded to mid stretch, was caught at the eighth pole but dug back in and was game to the wire. A B NOODLE pressed the pace to the second turn, tried to rally when asked to the stretch but weakened through the drive. KNOCKOUT CROWN tracked the pace from the rail to the second turn then tired.
