STAKES Minnesota Classic Championship S. Black Type - Thoroughbred

FOR THREE YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD WHICH ARE REGISTERED MINNESOTA BREDS. \$25 to nominate, \$225 to pass the entry box and \$225 additional to start, with \$40,000 guaranteed (\$20,900 from Canterbury Park and \$14,500 from the Minnesota Breeders' Fund), of which \$24,000 guaranteed to the owner of the winner. All other purse monies paid corresponding with purse schedule in Condition Book. Weights: Three-year-olds, 117 lbs; Older, 122 lbs. Non-winners of \$18,000 at one mile or over in 2005-2006 allowed 3 lbs; \$15,000 in 2005-2006, 5 lbs; \$10,000 in 2005-2006, 7 lbs. (Maiden, Claiming and Starter races not considered in allowances). HIGH WEIGHTS PREFERRED (On the Scale). (Winners Preferred). Total earnings in 2005-2006 will be used in determining the order of preference of horses assigned equal weights. The field will be limited to 12 horses. Horses not drawing a starting position in the gate will receive a refund of the entry fee. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner by Canterbury Park. Nominations closed Thursday, August 10 with 17. (S)

ROCK' N FIRE was sent clear into the first turn, turned back a challenge from MACK'S MONARCH on the second bend, forged clear in upper stretch, bolted to the outside at the furlong marker, then recovered his stride under brisk right handed pressure to regain the lead drifting in through the final sixteenth. MACK'S MONARCH tracked just outside the pacesetter to the backstretch, pressed that foe entering the far turn, proved no match in the drive, took the lead momentarily between calls in late stages, but couldn't contain the winner. ROUST ABOUT was angled to the rail early, tracked the leaders to the far turn and made an effort to improve his position in the lane. GOPHER THIS ONE was allowed to settle outside foes but never gained striking distance. WINTER TRICK tracked just off the leaders along the inside for a half, then emptied out on the far turn.
