GENUINE TALENT dueled outside a rival on the backstretch and turn, took a short lead nearing the stretch, inched away past midstretch and won clear under urging. GRAN TENOR chased outside a rival, moved up inside on the turn, was in tight off heels passing the quarter pole and again into the stretch, got through along the rail in the drive and edged a foe late for second. STELLA'S POSADA four wide early, stalked outside a rival, came three deep into the stretch, bid outside the winner, could not match that one in the final furlong and was edged late for the place. EL BANCO chased inside, came out into the turn, continued outside a rival on the bend, came out again in the stretch and did not rally. LORD MYSTERIO between foes early, chased a bit off the rail then inside on the turn, came out in the stretch and lacked the needed response. SEQUOIA KING had good early speed and dueled inside, came a bit off the rail while dropping back into the stretch and weakened.
