CATALISSA angled in toward the inside to save ground on the backstretch, rallied on the inside on the turn then swung outside of CALL ME LEFTY then was in a steady drive to draw off in late stretch. CALL ME LEFTY chased the early pace while five wide then rallied to gain command in mid stretch then tired in late stretch. SENECA ROCK was unhurried early then swung out six wide on the turn when blocked, was closing well in the stretch and finished with good energy late. FATHER MARTIN set a fast pace from the inside, drew off between calls the weakened in the stretch drive. ALEDO PASS was unhurried early then was blocked on the turn, split rivals and made a mild rally in the stretch. ACTION TONIGHT made a four wide middle move on the turn and was no threat. CUT THE RIBBON chased the pace while four wide, was hard used and faltered in the stretch. SCREEN PASS made a five wide middle move on the turn then flattened out in the stretch. MAKE JOE'S DAY was no factor. NUMEROUS AFFAIRS was on the inside on the turn and lacked a rally. HIGH OCTAVE chased the early pace from the inside, was used up and stopped. LASTTORUN chased the pace while three wide, was used up and stopped.
