DRESSED IN HERMES stalked inside then came off the rail on the backstretch, went three deep into and on the second turn, bid outside the runner-up in midstretch, gained the lead nearing the sixteenth pole and proved best under some urging. IT'S THE ICE (GB) had good early speed and set the pace inside, drifted out into the stretch, fought back off the rail in the final furlong and continued willingly but could not quite match the winner. SORRYABOUTNOTHING stalked off the rail then between horses on the second turn and into the stretch, continued willingly toward the inside for the show. ARCATURE chased outside a rival then three deep leaving the backstretch and on the second turn and into the stretch and was edged for third. MARQULA bumped at the start, pulled his way along to chase the pace outside a rival then between foes leaving the backstretch and into the second turn, continued just off the inside leaving that turn and lacked the needed late kick. MR. ROARY bumped at the break, angled in on the first turn and saved ground stalking the pace, inched forward on the second turn, continued inside in the stretch and could not summon the necessary late response.
