Footnotes

RALLY CRY three wide through the opening bend latched on the leader, prompted that rival from the three path down the backstretch, came under light coaxing midway on the far turn, advanced to take over command spinning just off the inside for home, came under urging straightened away for home and burst away to the eighth pole, went clear under a vigorous hand ride to the finish. RED RIFLE got bumped at the start by MO TOM then was lightly pinched back by MOHAYMEN who recovered outwards from a bobble, settled detached three wide at the rear of the field, came under coaxing seven-sixteenths from home, angled five to six wide into upper stretch, improved position in the drive to secure the place honors in the final jumps. CONQUEST WINDYCITY established the front and showed the way just off the inside through the first turn under some pressure to the outside by the eventual winner, came under light coaxing with six furlongs remaining, had the pressure rise into the far turn and was put to urging at the three-eighths, got headed at the quarter pole and cut the corner into upper stretch, dug in under a drive shaken off by the top one and weakened in the final eighth getting caught in the final strides and forced to settle for the show honors. MO TOM broke in at the start bumping RED RIFLE, settled three wide in pursuit from near the rear, came under coaxing half a mile from home, advanced through the turn into striking range, swung four to five wide into upper stretch, couldn't sustain the mild momentum and weakened in the stretch. MOHAYMEN bobbled at the start recovering outwards and lightly pinching back RED RIFLE before being corrected to avoid bumping CONQUEST WINDYCITY, tracked the top pair along the inside from within striking range, came under encouragement three furlongs from home and began to back away coming up empty, swung four wide into upper stretch and was eased through the final furlong to the finish.
