**Footnotes**

PIONEER SPIRIT eased just off the pace in the opening stages, saved ground while tracking just off the leaders on the bend, angled three wide leaving the turn while gradually getting on terms with SATCHMO and caught that rival on the wire while drifting out under a heavy drive. The latter forced the pace three deep to the turn, continued well to gain steadily on EXCLUSIVE EXAMPLE into the stretch, collared that rival in late stages and was bobbed at the wire. EXCLUSIVE EXAMPLE moved up to set the pace just off the rail into the turn, edged clear after a half and responded gamely to his rivals' late efforts. KALISPELL, void of early speed, made a steady advance on the rail while proving no threat. YANKEE STAR settled in midpack and had no response after three eighths. BOLD COMMOTION prompted the pace to the turn racing between foes and gave way. ROCK AND ROLL MAN, void of early speed, saved ground throughout while proving no factor. MY OTHER SOCK, four wide on the turn, showed little. SENATOR SLEW refused at the start and trailed. LIVELY IMAGE flashed brief pace four wide and faltered.
