Footnotes

ESSENTIAL QUALITY was urged along while racing in midpack down the backstretch, picked up stride and advanced on his own around the turn, loomed behind the leaders turning for home, lacked room while trying to slit those foes in upper stretch, switched out to the three at the three sixteenths pole, then sustained his rally to make a bid passing the furlong pole, and won going away. KING'S MISCHIEF prompted the pace three wide early on, then two wide around the turn, inched forward leaving the turn to forge an advantage at the three sixteenths pole, cleared off an held an advantage passing the furlong pole, but was no match for ESSENTIAL QUALITY approaching the sixteenth pole, then tired but held place. SANTA CRUISER was off slowly, saved ground around the turn while off of the pace, advanced while shifting to the two then three path turning for home, split foes in upper stretch, but chased ESSENTIAL QUALITY through the final furlong, and missed achieving place. RYE SENSE OF HUMOR raced far off of the pace in the three path around the turn, swung to the six path turning for home, and produced a mild rally. COPLEY chased the pace from the two to three path around the turn before shifting four wide turning for home to produce a bid, but failed to keep pace with the leading group in midstretch. COPA set the pace along the inside, cleared off at the five

furlong pole, shifted to the three path into the turn before angling back to the inside around the bend, but was headed by foes at the quarter pole, and weakened. DEVIL'S TOWER stumbled at the start but was not cost position, pressed the pace two wide and between horses early on, shifted in and stalked from the inside into the turn, but failed to keep pace with the leaders at the quarter pole. LOCK UP was forwardly placed three to four wide around the turn before shifting five wide turning for home, but weakened on his left lead in upper stretch. T MONEY was bumped by an outer foe at the start, raced far off of the pace two wide into the turn, and failed to factor. ME WE bumped an inner foe at the start, raced off of the pace in the two path around the turn, and never got involved. XIETELHUAS was off slowly and outrun along the inside.
