Non-winners of \$35,000 other than maiden or claiming at one mile or over since May 1 or such a race of \$50,000 since September 1, 2011, allowed 2 lbs.; of such a race of \$35,000 in 2012 or arace of \$50,000 any distance since September 1, 2011, 4 lbs. High weights preferred. *\$50,000 to the winner. Nominations closed Thursday, August 23, 2012 with 26.

JOHN SCOTT stalked three deep early then outside a rival, continued three wide on the backstretch and into the second turn, bid alongside the pacesetter leaving that turn, took the lead into the stretch, inched away nearing midstretch and held on gamely under urging. KETTLE CORN angled in on the first turn and stalked inside, waited off heels leaving the second turn, came out for room into the stretch, was in a bit tight off heels past midstretch, found room between foes in deep stretch and finished willingly to just miss. HOLLADAY ROAD saved ground chasing the pace, came out on the second turn, split horses three wide leaving that turn and into the stretch and edged a rival for the show. TRES BORRACHOS sent inside to the early lead, set the pace along the rail, fought back leaving the second turn and into the stretch, continued willingly along the fence and was edged for third. POSITIVE RESPONSE allowed to settle outside a rival chasing the pace, came out four wide leaving the second turn and into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. MIDNIGHT INTERLUDE stalked the pace a bit off the rail then between horses on the backstretch and second turn and weakened in the drive.
