Supplemental nominations of \$3,000 will be accepted at time of entry which shall include all fees. \$100,000 Guaranteed of which \$60,000 to the winner, \$20,000 to second, \$11,000 to third, \$6,000 to fourth, \$3,000 to fifth. Weight: Three Year Olds - 121 lbs; Older - 124 lbs. Non-winners of agrated sweepstakes at a mile or over in 2015 allowed 2 lbs. \$36,000 twice at a mile or over in 2015 allowed 4 lbs. Non-winners of three races at a mile or over in 2015 other than maiden, claiming or starter allowed 6 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. The Louisiana Champions Day Ladies will be limited to fourteen (14) starters. Preference to horses that have accumulated the highest total earnings in 2015. Any horse excluded from running because of the aforementioned preference shall be refunded the entry fee or the supplementary nomination fee if applicable. Footnotes

PACIFIC PINK brushed with ALIANA early, raced in the two path on the first turn, was reserved off the pace, moved up between horses with a half-mile to run, drafted in the two path while still between horses on the far turn, was asked coming to the five-sixteenths, came out in upper stretch, bumped PRIVATE PROMISE while trying to find room at the three-sixteenths, jostled the hindquarters of that rival while bullying her way through at the eighth-pole, made a bid between horses at the sixteenth-pole and proved best while eased up in the final strides. PRIVATE PROMISE went three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, drafted in the three path early on the far turn, was asked at the five-sixteenths, chased four wide into the stretch, was bumped by the winner at the three-sixteenths pole then again at the eighth-pole, made a bid at that point, battled into the final sixteenth and was outfinished while able to get the place. INDIAN WIND stalked the pace on the outside while racing in the two path, drew even late on the backstretch, vied in the two path on the far turn, was asked at the five-sixteenths, came under a right-handed whip in upper stretch, battled into the final sixteenth and was also outfinished while just able to get the show. DISCREETLY GRAND was rated under a snug hold on the inside, drafted inside on the far turn, was shuffled back when HEATSEEKER SHARON dropped back from the five-sixteenths to the quarter-pole, shifted three wide into the stretch, moved out while put to a drive, dropped in at the furlong marker, slipped past a rival along the rail, came back out late and finished willingly to just miss the show. HEATSEEKER SHARON was well rated while setting the pace on the inside, came under urging midway through the far turn, dropped back at the five-sixteenths and stopped. ALIANA brushed with PACIFIC PINK early, went three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was asked near the seven-sixteenths pole, made a strong early move to make a bid while four then three wide on the far turn, came under the whip in upper stretch, vied into the final furlong then faltered badly and was pulled up just after passing the wire then vanned off.
