THIRD CHANCE secured the lead near the inside soon after the break, dictated the pace on her own courage on a narrow margin racing into the bend, shook clear in upper stretch and widened her advantage to the end in a ridden out effort. JOYCE MARIE broke sharply, attended a rival's pace racing to the turn, pressed the issue into upper stretch, proved no match in the final stages but continued well enough to prove best of the others. SAM'S PHILLY, held up off the pace while angling inwards a bit in the opening quarter, split foes racing into upper stretch and continued well enough to gain a share. DE LICA, reserved in the last flight outside a rival, shifted out to split foes racing into upper stretch and improved her position in late stages. POINT YOUR FINGER settled along the inside early, shifted out to split foes in tandem with a rival racing into upper stretch but made no impression on the leaders. TURTLE PIE joined the pace three wide soon after the start, chased the leaders in that path into upper stretch and gave way. WILDCAT MISS tracked the leaders in second flight between foes racing into the bend but couldn't produce the needed closing bid. ROYAL ALLUVIAL, caught six wide in the opening stages tracking the leaders from just out striking distance under some reserve, was caught in that path racing through the bend and steadily faded from contention. LADY ROCKET was a brief factor between foes in the second flight but steadily retreated nearing upper stretch. LUCK BE A LADYBUG dropped out of
