Footnotes

CAME HOME had good early speed and dueled inside a rival on the backstretch and into the turn, inched away a bit off the rail on the bend and drew clear under a moderate hand ride. METATRON a bit crowded at the start, stalked the pace off the rail on the backstretch, angled in and inched up on the turn, steadied behind the winner leaving the turn, came out in the stretch and was clearly second best. A MAJOR PLEASURE broke in a bit, was unhurried off the inside, angled to the rail leaving the backstretch, advanced inside leaving the turn, remained along the rail and picked up the show. TRACEMARK allowed to settle off the rail, went outside a rival on the turn and lacked the needed late response. TIM'S TALENT forced the pace outside the winner on the backstretch and into the turn, stalked outside the runner-up on the bend, dropped back, drifted out some into the stretch and weakened. PHONEY GOLD saved ground chasing the leaders, dropped back between horses on the turn and gave way.
