Footnotes

FIFTYSHADESOFHAY bumped lightly at the start, had speed between horses then stalked just off the rail, bid alongside the pacesetter to gain command on the second turn and inched away, then kicked clear in the stretch under urging. HEIR KITTY angled in and chased inside then off the rail, went between horses into the second turn, split rivals midway on that turn then angled to the inside into the stretch, came out in midstretch, could not make an impact on the winner in the final furlong but held second. SCARLET STRIKE chased a bit off the inside, moved up three deep into and on the second turn and into the stretch and bested the others. SWITCH TO THE LEAD three deep nearing the first turn, chased off the rail, dropped back leaving the second turn, gave way and was eased in the stretch. ESCAPE ACT bumped with the winner at the start, sped to the early lead, inched away and set the pace inside, dueled on the backstretch and into the second turn, dropped back once headed on that turn, also gave way and was eased in the stretch. HEIR KITTY wore calks.
