BALLADO'S THUNDER stalked the pace off the rail, bid alongside the pacesetter and took the lead on the second turn, inched away and angled in entering the stretch and drew clear under urging. FREAKIN STREAKIN allowed to settle outside a rival chasing the pace, moved up on the second turn, came out into the stretch and gained the place. KRIS' SIS stalked the pace inside, came out leaving the second turn and into the stretch and bested the rest. MUSICAL ECHO (GB) sped to the early lead and angled in, set the pace inside, dueled inside the winner on the second turn and weakened in the stretch. POLITICAL WEB chased between horses then a bit off the rail, continued inside on the second turn and in the stretch and lacked the needed rally. VANGUARDA (ARG) saved ground off the pace, came out in the stretch and failed to menace. MAZELLA three deep into the first turn, stalked outside a rival, dropped back leaving the second turn and weakened. NEUILLY (BRZ) settled a bit off the rail then outside a rival, angled in on the second turn, came out into the stretch and was not a threat.
