REMEMBER BOFFI well placed early, lodged a three wide bid on the turn and responded gamely to prevail. RULE BY FORCE broke alertly and outward some, vied for the early lead, held the advantage turning for home and was under strong right handed pressure but was outfinished late. DIXIELAND EASY saved ground and vied for the lead then weakened in the drive. POLISH PETE broke in and well placed while just off the inside, raced along the rail entering the stretch, moved out nearing the sixteenth pole and lacked needed response. WEGOTTAGETALONG stumbled at the start, saved ground and lacked the needed bid. INDIAN FESTIVAL came out some and steadied some at the start, lacked a rally. INTEREST EARNINGS in a bit close at the start, failed to menace.
