Footnotes

FOOL PROOF stalked the early pace from the inside, steadily advanced entering the second turn, responded when asked and steadily drew clear under steady urging. MC TAGGART far back early, advanced inside up the backstretch, altered outside entering the drive and finished well. LIVELY REPARATIONS chased the early pace from the outside, made a bid entering the second turn but could only gain the show. WORKING FOR PEACE forced the early pace outside but had nothing left. SHEIK SHALOM up close early from the outside, made a bid entering the second turn, gained the advantage but could not last. MILWAUKEE FUN could only pass tired ones. VENTURE FUND stumbled at the start and was no factor. POW WOW POWER was no threat. WESH'S TEXAS STAR was no menace. HENRY THE LOVER broke well from between foes to gain the early advantage, lost irons and gave way.
