DR BLARNEY quickly secured command well off the rail, rated along continuing off the inside up the backstretch, shook off DOUGLAS ROAD after six furlongs and widened confidently under light hand urging. JUST WHISTLE was never far back while two wide for six furlongs, moved inside turning for home, and edged RERIDE through a long battle for the place. RERIDE raced four wide early, remained in range three wide to the stretch, and lacked a final rally. DOUGLAS ROAD prompted the pace outside DR BLARNEY, challenged in earnest on the far turn, was shaken off into the lane and faded. COLONEL JUAN lagged at the rear early inside, moved to the two-path around the far turn and did not make his presence felt. IMPERATIVE broke awkwardly, raced three wide on the far turn, and could not gain. GENERAL DOWNS raced close-up early inside, but faltered badly after six furlongs.
