IDE LIKE A DOUBLE settled inside off the leaders, rallied approaching the drive, got through inside CLASSY DEELITES approaching mid stretch and then quickly drew out. PANTARA PHANTOM vied for the lead in the early going, took back after entering the backstretch, moved out down the backstretch, made a run at the leaders and while no match for the winner was best of the rest. CUBERA inside to the drive, eased out and then got up for the show. GRAND LEGACY angled in going to the first turn, was reserved until the second turn, angled out entering the drive and showed late interest. CLASSY DEELITES vied for the lead, got clear down the backstretch, was headed inside the furlong marker and then faltered late. PETEADORIS reserved from early on, moved up nearing the drive and then had no final kick. D' TRAIN well back to before the drive, was no real threat. SNUG steadied early when GRAND LEGACY angled in approaching the first turn, saved ground until the drive and was outrun. TENSAS WHY GIN close up until nearing the drive, stopped.
