FIVE STAR DAY moved quickly to gain command shortly after leaving the chute, made the pace racing off the rail, then drew clear in early stretch and remained clear to the wire under a steady hand ride. SILVER SEASON unhurried while racing off the rail, angled out leaving the turn and rallied to gain the place. ABAJO steadied when caught in tight midway along the backstretch, angled to the rail and made a run at the leader around the turn, then tired in the drive. MR. UNITED STATES outrun early, failed to menace while passing tired rivals. LIFEISAWHIRL chased the pace five wide into the turn, continued on in striking position four wide around the turn and faltered. HIDDEN CITY forced the early pace three wide and faded. BET ME BEST chased the leaders four wide into the turn and stopped.
